WHAT TO DO IF....



There is a medical emergency?

- If it is an emergency that is life-threatening, please call 000 first.
- Then call the first aider whose number is listed on your volunteer lanyard.
- If an ambulance is required, please call a committee or farm contact listed on your lanyard so the crowd can be managed, and we can get help to who may need it.
- Examples of an emergency are symptoms of a heart attack, anaphylaxis, seizures, severe asthma attack, and extreme physical harm.
- All medical emergencies must have either an incident report form or a first aid form completed.

What to do if someone needs minor first aid?

- If it is a minor injury (a cut or scrape) please send them to the first aid area nearest to you. The location of first aid stations is shown on the show maps.
- If it is a serious injury yet not an emergency, please call the first aider listed on your contact list.

A parent has lost their child, what do I do?

 Keep the parent in the same location they lost their child for 2-5 minutes and notify a nearby person with a radio or call the contact on your lanyard. Keep the parent calm and keep them with you, we need the parent to stay close while we look for the child. The situation needs to stay controlled.



I found a lost child.

- Stay in the same location for 2-5 minutes.
- Longer than five minutes, please take the child to the front office or notify someone who can come and collect the child for you if in a fixed position.
- Keep the child calm and tell them it's okay. Try and ask for their name and their parent's name or any other details the child may know if possible.

I have witnessed inappropriate behaviour, or a serious situation has been disclosed to me.

- DO NOT intervene, please contact the appropriate contact listed on your lanyard. If it is an emergency, contact the site's police officer.
- If unsure contact the Volunteer Coordinator, Doveton Show committee member or the Farm office.

I need to leave for a personal emergency/ I have become sick and need someone to cover my position.

- Call the Volunteer Coordinator and we can find a replacement for you.
- We understand!! Things happen during the day, and you may need to head off, that's fine, but please call first so that we can ensure we have your position covered.
